I have enjoyed your "live" coverage of Canadian Professional Football and College Basketball (ESPN+). I am not a great fan of 24 hour delayed sports coverage, but I do ocassionally watch a Grizzlies baseball game or a Falcon Hockey game. They, as well as local high school/community college football/basketball should be carried "live".

The purpose, however, of my communication is the absence of any national interest sports coverage on your stations (channels 32-33-43) which I receive fairly well "over-the-air" (I don't have cable - I have "Dish" without the locals). I would like to see you add on these 3 independents the 15 Giants' baseball games not picked up for the 2006 season by KFRE from t KTVU and the Giants' TV Network, including 4 with the Dodgers, and 3 with the Padres. There are also 44 Oakland A's telecasts available from KICU (channel 36, San Jose; COX TV) and the Athletics' TV Network (including affiliates in Sacramento/Reno). Following baseball season, the Sacramento Kings (NBA) have about 20 games available "over the air" from TV News 10 in Sacramento. From Southern California, KCAL televises 40+ Dodger baseball games and all of the Laker (NBA) road games for over the air release. These sports events would be well accepted by Fresno Area sports fans. All of these teams have full radio coverage in the Fresno market; the Giants/Lakers on KFIG/ESPN Radio; The Dodgers and Sacramento Kings on KCBL; and the Oakland A's on KYOS. I would really appreciate consideration of these suggestions and a response to this email message.
